Where is the Dust Bowl Lanes & Lounge?

Tulsa: 211 S Elgin Avenue

Oklahoma City: 421 NW 10th Street

Little Rock: 315 E. Capitol Avenue

What are your hours of operation?

The Dust Bowl is open 7-days a week. Below are our general hours, though they can be affected by private parties and holidays.

Monday - Friday 4:00 p.m. - late

Saturday 12:00 p.m. - 2:00 a.m.

Sunday 12:00 p.m. - 12:00 a.m.

*Dust Bowl OKC opens at 11:00 a.m. on Saturdays and Sundays

What is your age and ID policy?

The Dust Bowl is all ages facility until 8:00 p.m. Guests must have a valid ID to drink alcoholic beverages or to enter the establishment after 8:00 p.m. Also, please note that a parent or guardian must accompany all guests under the age of 21.

What if our family is not finished with our game at 8:00 p.m.?

Guests will not be asked to leave the facility as the clock strikes 8:00 p.m. However, we will enforce a time limit if a game extends too far beyond 8:00 p.m.

Can I reserve a lane?

Yes, we accept lane reservations, but availability is limited so we can accommodate walk-in bowlers, too. We accept reservations 7-days a week for up to two hours. Weekend nights tend to be busy, so we do not accept reservation start-times for after 10:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday. You can request a reservation via our online reservation system:

How much does it cost to bowl?

Lanes are priced by the hour, not by the game. Visit our rates page for more information.

What is the wait on a Friday or Saturday night around 8 p.m.?

The wait for a lane depends upon a variety of factors, including events booked for that date, the size of groups currently bowling, the number of groups already on the waitlist, etc. An exact wait time cannot be determined for a particular time of day. However, if you are concerned about having lanes for a large group of people you can request a reservation by calling the following numbers:

How many people can bowl on a lane at one time?

Each public lane can accommodate up to 6 bowlers.

How many people can the private rooms accommodate?

Tulsa: The private room in Tulsa has two lanes. Those lanes can accommodate 12 bowlers, and 16-20 total guests.

Oklahoma City: The private room in OKC can be configured with two or four lanes. If configured for two lanes it can accommodate 12 bowlers, and 16-20 total guests. If configured for four lanes it can accommodate 24 bowlers, and 32-40 total guests.

Little Rock: The private room in Little Rock has two lanes. Those lanes can accommodate 12 bowlers, and 16-20 total guests.

Is it possible to rent the entire facility?

Yes, it is possible to rent the entire Dust Bowl. To get more information about an exclusive rental please complete the Plan A Party form [LINK TO FORM] and check the Exclusive Party box so one of our managers can get in touch with you.

What are your options for parties?

We have several party packages for both adults and children. Please contact us through our private party page for details.

Do you require bowling shoes?

Yes, bowling shoes are required for all players and may be rented for \$3.50 a pair.

Do you serve food?

Yes, Dust Bowl offers comfort food with a kick. Our menu, which you can check out by clicking [here](#), is available late night, too. We also offer a catering menu for larger parties.

What do I need to bring with me?

We have bowling shoes for adults and children that you can rent, plus socks you can purchase if you happen to be wearing flip-flops when you arrive. Therefore, unless you'd like an alcoholic beverage, or it's after 8:00 p.m., which means you'd need an ID, you can don't need to bring anything to enjoy the Dust Bowl.

Can I drop my child off at the Dust Bowl?

Unfortunately, no. The Dust Bowl requires adult supervision of any children at the facility.

What else is there to do at the Dust Bowl besides bowling?

Each Dust Bowl has a full-bar, food service, large screen TVs, and a lounge area. The Dust Bowl in Little Rock has a karaoke room. Even if you don't bowl, there is a lot to do at the Dust Bowl.

Does the Dust Bowl sell gift cards?

Yes, the Dust Bowl sells gift cards that can be purchased and redeemed at the bowling alley or any other McNellie's Group location.
